

Beach PPE – Standard minimum requirements



Refer to **Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Procedure (CDN/ID 18985400)**

Pants: Must be Flame Retardant and meet NFPA 70E HRC1 (PPE 1). (Beach personnel must be Blue)

Shirts/Jackets/Coveralls: High visibility and must meet NFPA 70E HRC1 (PPE 1). (Beach personnel must be Orange)

Contractors may have their own colour schemes but are required to comply with all other requirements in the procedure.

Foot protection - Steel or industrial plastic/composite, anti-static rated safety boots.

Safety glasses or safety prescription glasses with side shields or prescription glasses with over glasses

Hard hat (less than 2 years of age and no visible damage) per site requirements

Gloves to be carried and/or worn as per the site and task requirements

Hearing protection to be carried and worn as signposted (mandatory hearing protection areas)

Specialist PPE (for example respirator) as required per task requirements
