Below are just a few examples of organisations and projects across Australia and New Zealand making a difference in the community.

### Taranaki Community Rugby Trust (TCRT)

Beach Energy and TCRT's partnership promotes community rugby, focusing on Taranaki kids' fitness. They have distributed \$1,090,820 to date, enhancing health, welfare, and safety in the community.



### Deakin BCL

Coastal wetlands regeneration program to restore Victoria's wetlands and provide protection from storm surges and erosion, capture and storage of carbon dioxide, as blue carbon, increase habitat for coastal wildlife and help remove nutrient pollution from the water .

### SAM

Supporting the Sprigg Salon series by bringing together scientists and researchers to discuss STEM based issues. And the Aboriginal Living Languages Project with the focus on revival and maintenance of all 46 Aboriginal Languages in South Australia to be recovered, revitalised and shared.
