Below are just a few examples of organisations and projects in Victoria making a difference in the community.

Cobden Recreation Reserve

Funding towards installation of sports ground irrigation, which was previously watered by hand through volunteers. The initiative has significantly reduced the resources required to manage the surface and improved water efficiency for the ground used by hundreds of participants.



Westernport Swamp Landcare

Supported the delivery of environmental learning programs for primary school students from Lang Lang and Koo Wee Rup. Increasing students' knowledge of the local flora and fauna, and how to look after the environment.

Creative Minds Art and Support

Providing art opportunities for neurodivergent children in the local community, running weekly classes and holiday workshops guided by an art teacher. Additionally, connecting parents of neurodivergent children to increase support.

Delivered initiatives to recruit and retain cadet and senior members. Including development programs sending members to statewide camps, national programs, and inspiring leadership trips.
