Below are just a few examples of organisations and projects in Victoria making a difference in the community.

Timboon Recreation Reserve

Redevelopment of their court facilities involved reconstructing ageing tennis and netball courts into safe, compliant multi-use surfaces, improving playability and accessibility. The project delivered high-quality courts, eliminated safety risks, and created a long-term community asset supporting local sport, wellbeing and sporting facilities central to the region.



Neil Porter Legacy

Funding to deliver career education programs in the Corangamite Shire and beyond, including Beach's Energy Industry Day. Enabling hands on learning, skills development and exposure to energy career pathways for regional students.

Westernport Swamp Landcare

Funding for its Schools Environment Program, enabling local students to participate in hands-on, science-based learning at the Lang Lang arboretum, strengthening environmental awareness and community engagement.



Port Campbell Surf Life Saving Club

Funded youth development and retention programs, enabling leadership training, camps and upgraded equipment. This strengthened junior and senior member participation, supported Nippers programs, and helped sustain the club's future volunteer base.
